Volunteers are needed to help maintain our parish grounds and Saint Michael Park. We currently are seeking extra help with weekly trimming and edging around our property.

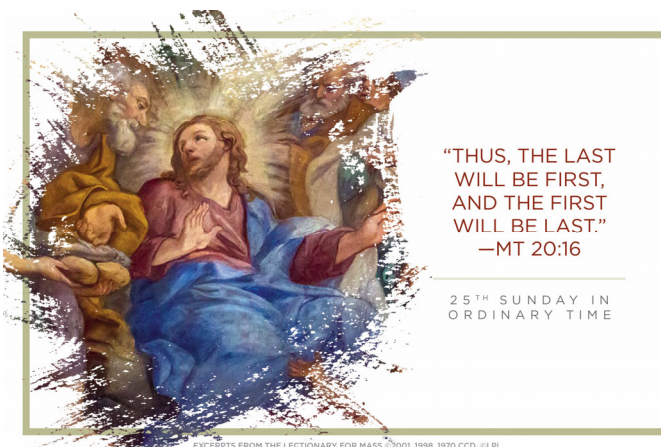

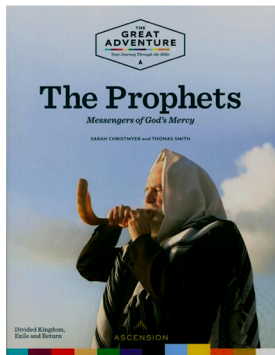


On Friday, September 29th, we celebrate the feast of these three archangels who are venerated in the tradition of the Church. *Michael* (Who is like God?) was the archangel who fought against Satan and all his evil angels, defending all the friends of God. He is the protector of all humanity from the snares of the devil. *Gabriel* (Strength of God) announced to Zachariah the forthcoming birth of John the Baptist, and to Mary, the birth of Jesus. His greeting to the Virgin, "Hail, full of grace," is one of the most familiar and frequent prayers of the Christian people. *Raphael* (Medicine of God) is the archangel who took care of Tobias on his journey.

In her liturgy, the Church joins with the angels to adore the thrice-holy God, and She invokes their assistance. Devotion among the Christian faithful to the Holy Angels gives rise to a devout gratitude to God for having placed these heavenly spirits of great sanctity and dignity at the service of man, and an attitude of serenity and confidence in facing difficult situations, since the Lord guides and protects the faithful in the way of justice through the ministry of His Holy Angels.
